The number of reported cases increased by 7677 cases. The average number of tests per day increased by 1845 tests. Percent positivity increased 5.69% over the last 28 days and increased 7.68% over the last 7 days. Deaths increased by .06% for this reporting period. The percentage of cases hospitalized decreased by .08%. There was an increase in cases observed for all age groups. Healthcare capacity in many places is still at or nearing capacity with a range of 44-99%. Testing, tracing, containment and infrastructure remain stable.
